CAMP GUIDE

## **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR EVERYONE**

- No physical contact allowed between male and female campers
- No clothing or accessories with inappropriate graphics or wording
- No hats or sunglasses in the tabernacle
- Proper dress code will be enforced with a smile
- No loitering around opposite genders' cabins
- Obey dress code to and from swimming hole
- Respect and obey all authority
- Proper respect, involvement, and behavior in tabernacle and during competition

## **DRESS CODE FOR LADIES**

- Modest knee-length skirts, dresses, and skirt-appearing culottes
- Modest tops and t-shirts.
- Swimwear – modest one piece or two piece swimsuit (no bikinis), paired with shorts that reach at least fingertip length.

## **DRESS CODE FOR GENTLEMEN**

- No sleeveless shirts or tank tops
- Knee-length shorts can be worn during activity times (AM & PM)
- No jewelry (unless for medical identification purposes)
- Swimwear – modest shorts, cut-offs, or trunks

*Parent or youth pastor will be responsible to find a way home for a young person who: a) Goes to the swimming hole without a lifeguard on duty or when opposite Gender is there. b) Behaves inappropriately with the opposite gender*

## What to Pack:

- Bible & pen & notebook
- Multiple outfits for each day
  - Activity outfits
    - Girls: modest, knee-length culottes and t-shirt
    - Guys: pants or knee-length shorts and t-shirt
  - Service outfits *\*Nicer casual clothes are encouraged, but not required\**
    - Girls: modest, knee-length dress or skirt with modest top
    - Guys: pants and collared shirt
- Swimwear (see dress code)
  - (all campers must be fully dressed when walking to and from the swimming hole)
- Shoes: tennis shoes for field games, flip flops and sandals for service times
- Sleeping bag or twin sheets & blankets & pillow
- Flashlight
- Insect repellent & sunscreen
- Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, body wash, deodorant, etc)
- Towels (recommended 2- one for shower, one for swim)
- Cash for the concessions, camp store, and ice cream shop
  - \*optional, but recommended\*

## What NOT to Pack:

Cell phones, electronic and media devices, magazines, gaming systems, alcohol, cigarettes, vapes, drugs, knives, firearms, or other weapons, non-prescription drugs, paintballs, fireworks
