Even the elect of the past ages, who were on Mount Zion but not on the top, you see, they will go up to the top of Mount Zion: When they are resurrected in their eternal bodies, where will they come to? To the top of Mount Zion, to our age (because their age has already ended); and they will be with us in that glorious manifestation of the children of God on the top of Mount Zion.

Sometimes there are people who think: “If God sends a man, a prophet, to Earth, everybody will receive him. And if he sends the Messiah, everybody will receive Him.” But history shows that this is not so. History shows that people have always risen up; and, unfortunately, the greatest enemies have been religious leaders and religions; and mainly the religion established at that time as the religion of the State.

(...) People have to sit down, pray to God, and say: “If this man is a messenger of God, as he is saying and as he is showing by the Scriptures: We want to know all the Scriptures that speak of

this end time, we want to see where are the Scriptures that speak of a prophet messenger that God will send, we want to see those messianic promises that are there. And if they are being fulfilled in this man, we can't do anything else but say: This is what we were waiting for!"

(...) Now, these wise men, after they worshipped Jesus and gave their presents, their gifts, were warned by the Archangel Gabriel to return to their homeland by another path, and not to return to Jerusalem to give the news that they had found the Messiah.

Now, look how God protects His Sent One, His Anointed One, His veil of flesh where He would dwell. God has always done so, because He protects the ministerial gift that He places in that person.

Some people may think: "No, if God does something, God is going to make it known to every person, or it has to be made known to every person." Well, look, the Archangel Gabriel said to him: "Don't go back to Jerusalem, to make known this news that you have found the Messiah and where He is." Why? Because Herod's intentions were not good.

And the one who doesn't have good intentions, God doesn't allow him to know His Program: It is hidden from those people; because they don't have a good intention in their soul, in their heart, and what they would try to do is to destroy all that Program that God is carrying out.

ON THE UPDATED MOUNT TRANSFIGURATION

We find that there Moses and Elijah were talking to Jesus about His departure for Jerusalem. The mystery for the adoption of the Son of God was there: Moses and Elijah ministering the Word to Him, ministering the Word to Jesus, telling Him of His departure for Jerusalem.

The ministry of Moses and Elijah is promised for the end of time, for the adoption of all of God's elect.

Among the seven angel messengers there was one with the spirit and power of Elijah, but he didn't have the spirit and power of

Moses; for the spirit and power of Moses, and the spirit and power of Elijah, is for the adoption of all the sons of God, for the Age of Adoption, for the Age of the updated Mount Transfiguration.

Therefore, the ministry of Moses and Elijah must be seen operating, ministering the Word to the children of God, to the Firstborn of God, who will be adopted at the end of time as children of God and will receive all that Adam and Eve lost in the fall: The Title Deed will be restored to them and an eternal body will be restored to all the children of God. This is promised for every child of God, so that the Kingdom of God will be restored to the children of God.

(...) It is very important to see the updated Mount Transfiguration; because only those who are on the updated Mount Transfiguration, on the top of that Mount Zion, are the ones who will be able to see Moses and Elijah giving us the Message of the Gospel of the Kingdom, they will be able to see the ministries of Moses and Elijah being repeated at the end of time in the Angel of the Lord Jesus Christ, according to the divine promise.

No one else can see the ministries of Moses and Elijah operating, except those on the updated Mount Transfiguration; and especially those at the top, in the part of the Age of the Cornerstone.

Because we find that Peter, James and John went up with Jesus; and the other disciples stayed at the bottom of the mountain, they didn't see what was going on up at the top of the mountain: They were not seeing the adoption of the Son of God, they were not seeing the adoption of the Firstborn of God, they were not seeing Moses and Elijah talking to the Firstborn of God who was being adopted.

The other disciples had a problem below. They had taken a young man who had a problem, his father took him so that Jesus' disciples would cast out the demon he had, but they couldn't. And then the disciples ask Jesus: "Why couldn't we cast out that demon?"

At that moment they were living in a very important vision: In the vision of the Coming of the Kingdom of God, which the disciples of Jesus were seeing: Peter, James and John. And all that was happening at the top of the mountain, and also below, was the type and figure of what would be happening at the end of time.
