and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell (that is, hades) followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth."

That is the antichrist, the man of sin, in whom the devil will be incarnated and who comes there as the rider of the yellow horse. That is where the enemy comes as a river: he comes with nations, he comes with armies of those nations that will give him their power and authority, he comes as the Jordan (the Jordan represents death). And there the rider of the yellow horse says that his name is Death, and hell followed him.

And now, that is where we will have that confrontation and where there will come a squeeze. But we are going to cross over the Jordan dry: without seeing death, because it is promised.

It says: "But when we return..." Let's see... [*Quotations*, p. 69]:¹

"And when we strike Jordan, with Christ, we got one portion, but when we return, we're coming with two portions (and now let's see which are the two portions). We got Eternal Life, resurrection from sin, now, in righteousness with the Holy Ghost. And then on the return, with Christ, we come back with both physical resurrection, and we already got spiritual resurrection. We have a double portion of it."

And now, for His Second Coming He will bring a new name, which will have to do with the Work that He will do as King of kings and Lord of lords, it will have to do with the Work that He will do in His Kingdom, the Kingdom that He will establish on this planet Earth; because the kingdoms of this world will become of our God and of His Christ, of His Anointed One, of the Lord's Anointed One.

And now, we are seeing that something big has to happen in this end time.

It goes on to say in verse 19, of this same chapter 19 of Revelation:

"And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army."
